



Campsite regulations of the Neuhausen a.d.F. recreation ground

(Status: 14.05.2023)

1. Registration

The campsite is open to all organised youth groups. The occupancy of our campsite requires written registration.

2. Usage fee

The usage fee is € 2.50 per person per night.

The water is charged separately. A fee of 50 € is charged per filling of the water truck (2000 litres).

A registration fee of 100 € is due with the written registration. This will be deducted from the final invoice on departure.

3. Motor vehicles

Driving on the site is only permitted on the gravelled area. Vehicles (max. 2 vehicles) must be parked on the area next to the water truck. Driving on the paved area next to the pergola is prohibited and will be charged with 50 € per vehicle!

4. Sanitary facilities

The sanitary facilities are equipped with separate WCs, washrooms and showers for women and men. The washing areas are for personal hygiene only. Please, also in your own financial interest, use water sparingly. Wastewater is collected in an underground pit. The costs for disposal (removal by a specialised company to the sewage treatment plant) are very high.

5. Meadow

No holes or ditches may be dug on the playing field. Holes may be dug in the lower area between the trees after consultation with the site manager.

Trees and shrubs must not be damaged or felled under any circumstances.

Please water the fruit trees and the raised garden bed. Apples from the fruit trees and herbs from the raised garden bed are welcome to be eaten.

6. Waste

Waste is disposed of by the group itself. Biological waste may not be buried on the site as it is located in a water protection area.

7. Fireplace

Fires may only be lit on the fireplace. Attention must be paid to the danger of forest fires. Firewood can be collected in the adjacent forest. Damaging or cutting down bushes and trees is strictly forbidden and will be charged to the group! Only dry and untreated wood may be burned!



8. Timber

The pole wood is only intended for building purposes and is counted. It may not be sawn or burned, nor may nails and screws be used. The construction wood must be piled up at the designated place next to the pergola before departure. Missing wood will be charged to the group.

9. Cleaning

The pergola and the group room are to be left swept clean and free of rubbish. The beer table sets must be neatly lined up again.

In the sanitary facilities, the toilets, wash basins and showers must be cleaned. The floor must be swept.

10. Technical problems

In case of technical problems with the sanitary facilities, e.g. blocked drain, water no longer running, etc., the site manager is to be contacted immediately.

11. Damages

Damage to the site and the buildings must be reported immediately to the site manager. The costs of repair and restoration to the original condition are to be borne by the party responsible.

12. Departure

The group leader is responsible for ensuring that the site, the sanitary facilities and the hut are left in a perfect condition. The site manager must be informed in good time before the departure.
